



Part Time Teacher of KS3 and IGCSE Spanish (Online – Self employed)

Net School is seeking a well-qualified and enthusiastic online teacher of Spanish to deliver classes to our Key Stage 3 and Year 10 IGCSE classes from September 2024.

The successful candidate will be:

- A UK qualified teacher, experienced in working with students at Key Stage 3 and 4.
- A holder of a current, Enhanced DBS certificate
- Comfortable delivering classes through an online classroom
- Equipped with their own computer and headset and have a reliable, fast internet connection to the location where they will be working
- Prepared to create their own resources where necessary
- Experienced in teaching Spanish at Key Stage 3 and IGCSE level (familiarity with the Edexcel IGCSE Spanish syllabus is desirable)
- A team player, willing to collaborate with other Net School teachers and administrative staff to bring about the best possible outcomes for our students.

The role comprises:

- Five hours of online teaching per week (currently timetabled on Mondays and Tuesdays but there is room for some flexibility if required)
- Setting and marking homework as required (usually one homework per class, per week, during term time)
- Responding in a timely manner to student/parent/administrator messages through our internal messaging system
- Writing end of term Progress Reports twice per year

Pay:

- Net School operates a pay scale based on the size of the class being taught, with further details on application.
- A small additional fee is paid for the writing of Progress Reports
- Teachers are paid half-termly, in arrears.
- There may also be opportunities during the year to take on additional work, such as 121 teaching or extra-curricular clubs, subject to demand.
- Net School class teachers are self-employed contractors, with a contract for services. They are responsible for their own income tax and National Insurance contributions.

Our teaching platforms:

- Net School's online classes are delivered live, through our Class Collaborate classrooms. These allow for whiteboard, file and screen sharing and for text chat, audio and visual interaction between students and teachers.
- Our Learning Management System (for posting resources, setting and marking assignments, and messaging) is Schoology.
- Training in both Class Collaborate and Schoology will be available to the successful candidate prior to them commencing teaching.
